RULES AND REGULATIONS.....

- 1. Entry day is Wednesday July 14, 2010 from 12:00 noon to 6:30 p.m.**
2. Open to Amateur exhibitors only- and no advertising permitted. An amateur pursues a hobby and may occasionally sell work. A professional earns a large portion of his livelihood from this pursuit.
3. Entries previously exhibited in our Open Class, may not be exhibited again.
4. Limit two entries per lot. May enter as many lots as desired.
5. Any entry not listed is welcome – if it is appropriate for a youth and family oriented fair.
6. Flowers, Gardening and Food will be judged on Wednesday evening. All other judging will be on Thursday.
7. The Fair Association is not responsible for any damage or loss to exhibits.
8. **Exhibits must be picked up between 8:00 am and 11:00 am on Sunday, July 18. Premiums and ribbons need to be picked up, along with exhibits. The Fair Association is not responsible for exhibits that are not removed during release time.**

Suggestions Blooms at or near peak. Cut early morning or late afternoon. With a very sharp knife, cut on a slant, leaving as much stem and leaves as possible. Fill container ½ full with warm water. Remove foliage below water line. Remove excess blossoms near stem leaving no knobs. Set in a cool place for 12 to 24 hours.
