Open Class offers an opportunity for anyone from preschoolers to senior citizens to enter their talents. The fair has classes and lots for just about anything from farm crops to flowers, crafts to photographs and from quilts to crocheting.

### **INFORMATION & REGULATIONS**

The Fair Board takes precautions for the safety of visitors and exhibits but assumes no liability for personal injury or loss/ damage to any property.

1. Entry day is **TUESDAY** July 12 (*new day*) from 12:00 noon to 6:30 p.m.
2. Release time is Sunday July 17 from 8:00 am and 10:30 am. Exhibits, premiums and ribbons must be picked up during those times. ***The Fair Board is not responsible for exhibits left after release time.***
3. Open to Amateur exhibitors only- and no advertising permitted. An amateur pursues a hobby and may occasionally sell work. A professional earns a large portion of his livelihood from this pursuit.
4. Entries previously exhibited in our Open Class, may not be exhibited again.
5. Limit two entries per lot. May enter as many lots as desired.
6. Any entry not listed is welcome – if it is appropriate for a youth and family oriented fair.
7. For faster registration, bring an address label for each entry.
8. Judging:
  - a. Open Class building will be closed during judging.
  - b. Flowers, Gardening and Food will be judged on Tuesday evening. All other judging will be on Wednesday.
  - c. Judges may withhold ribbons at any level, in any lot, if exhibits do not merit them, even if there is competition.
